



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Are all fundraising teams required to bowl?**
No, they may participate as “virtual bowlers” which mean participants raise money, but do not bowl the day of the event. These handlers will still qualify for an incentive if they meet their fundraising goal. In order to receive the incentives, all bowlers must register online as a member of the team.
- **If the \$1000 per team goal is not met, is the company obligated to donate the difference?**
No. The goal is \$1,000, which supports two classes of students receiving JA programs. If you do not reach it, there is no penalty. Of course if an individual does moonwalk to their goal of \$200 or more, they earn an incentive. We encourage bowlers to “Don’t stop ‘til we get enough!”
- **Is the bowling linked to the fundraising or is it just a celebratory end to the fundraising?**
The JA “Remember the Time” Bowl-A-Thon is a celebratory event for the money that has been raised to support JA.
- **Do the bowling scores contribute to the fundraising?**
No, the bowl-a-thon is just a way that JA thanks you for fundraising for us and to celebrate the money that you raised.
- **How will team members track their progress?**
Fundraising thermometers are located on the website. There are thermometers for individuals, teams and the overall campaign.
- **How will donations be collected?**
Donations will be collected online at www.georgia.ja.org. The bowlers will register online and send out emails that have links to their personal page where donors can make gifts. If a donor would like to make a gift via cash/check they may do so by mailing the gift to the attention of Bevan Mitchell-460 Abernathy Rd. Atlanta, GA 30328. Gifts made at office events will also be accepted via mail. Please make checks payable to JA of Georgia.
- **Will donors be provided with receipts?**
Yes, they will be emailed to them.
- **Do we pick one shift for the whole company?**
Your teams can bowl anytime they wish. Many companies choose to bowl during the same time to increase overall employee morale.
- **Does each team have their own lane, or do we have a company lane?**
Each team has their own lane.
- **Rules of Lane Decoration Contest**
There are no rules, Billie Jean. Just be sure that your team members dress up and that decoration are in place by the designated time.
- **Will bowlers be allowed to drink alcohol?**
You know its human nature, enjoy yourself. The bowling alleys offer a full menu and bar which can be ordered from at the bowler’s expense. JA pays for 2 hours of unlimited bowling and your bowling shoes.
